NEW FOR 2021! RURAL LIVING BOOTHS

While the Four State Farm Show has always been an agriculture only event, this brings non-ag companies the opportunity to also reach show attendees with their products in a designated indoor area. Plaster Center booths 321-408 are reserved just for Rural Living exhibitors. The booths are 10'x10' or multiples thereof, with electricity and side and back drop curtains included, in the climate-controlled building.

You have first right to your 2020 booth space assignment(s) highlighted on the enclosed map. Please contact the Show Coordinator, Lance Markley at 620-423-2355 with booth availability questions.

- **LIABILITY INSURANCE** – All 2021 show exhibitors must provide to show management, prior to setup, a Certificate of Liability Insurance in an amount not less than \$1,000,000. Greene County Agricultural and Mechanical Society dba Ozark Empire Fair, Four State Farm Show and Pittsburg State University must be named as additional insured. Management reserves the right to prohibit exhibitor from setting up or operating it's booth without having provided a certificate of insurance.
- **ATVs & UTVs** – The use of ATVs or UTVs for transportation on show grounds by exhibitors or spectators prior to, during or after the show is prohibited. These units are for stationary display purposes only, on booth space rented by show exhibitors. Golf carts are allowed and must be rented from the show supplier.
- **TENT, TABLE & CHAIR RENTAL** – For outside booth tent, table and chair rental, contact Weiser Tent Service, 800-798-0119. For inside table, chair and other decorator item rental contact Ozark Empire Fair, 417-833-2660. Each company provides rentals for their specific area only. In the event an exhibitor has both inside and outside booths, they will need to work with both suppliers.
- **SETUP & TEAR DOWN** – Setup hours are from 12:00 noon - 5:00 p.m. Monday and 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of show week. Forklift service will be available beginning at 12:00 noon Monday, May 17 (\$15.00 minimum charge) and continue through 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 25. All exhibits must be in place by 6:00 p.m. Thursday, May 20. As another event directly follows the Four State Farm Show, all inside booths must be removed by 12:00 noon Tuesday, May 25 and all outside booths by 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 26. No exceptions.
